DIY Accessories with Recyclable Materials

How does it work?

The workshop is open to individuals as young as 13 years old. During the workshop, participants learn the fundamentals of a zero-waste lifestyle, its benefits, and daily practises they can implement to lead a sustainable life. The participants then engage in a hands-on activity that teaches them techniques for creating accessories and other items from recyclable materials.

Educational Trip to “Green” Facilities

An exciting workshop that explores local facilities dedicated to environmental conservation, renewable energy, and waste management. This workshop deepens participants understanding of sustainability concepts and promotes the adoption of green practices in their daily lives.

How does it work?

InFo is an NGO located in Karditsa, Greece and wishes to actively promote the implementation of the UNs Sustainable Development Goals in the local community and transform people's everyday lives. This workshop takes participants to a variety of locations that implement sustainable practises and seek to promote sustainability. The workshop is open to individuals as young as 13 years old. During the workshop, participants discuss the importance of sustainable practices and the impact of "green" facilities on the environment. The group then visits two facilities that contribute to the area's green transition. During the tour, the participants examine the production process that the facilities follow and discuss with the staff the significance of the 9 Rs and waste management. They also discover ways to reduce waste generation at home.
