



## Circular Economy In Action

As we delve into training youth to adopt a zero-waste lifestyle in InAction project, our next goal would be preparing a guide for youth workers to train youth, and provide trainings to both of our target groups.

Following our Kick-off meeting in last year's July (2023), we set off with surveys and desk research in partner countries to depict how youth embrace zero-waste lifestyles and some of the best practices conducted in partner countries in achieving zero-waste.

Light being shed with the preliminary findings, we then continued with underlying topics in achieving a zero-waste lifestyle and developing a guide full of practices and workshops that can be easily implemented by youth in their everyday lives, to achieve a zero-waste lifestyle. The guide embodies a curriculum as well as several tips and resources on how to guide youth to get their communities involved and contribute to the sustainable development of their communities.

Finally, following the basis of the guide being laid down, we have had our first training event in Karditsa, Greece. The training took place between the 8th and 10th of July with participation of two youth workers from each partner country (Ekopotencjal-Poland, Innovation Footprint-Greece, and Stando Ltd.-Cyprus). The youth workers were trained on how to implement practical workshops to achieve zero-waste, such as DIY, and how such workshops can be delivered.

Having accomplished our first training, we are now looking forward to our local workshops with youth in partner countries, in which the trained youth workers will conduct workshops to train youth.



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
