# Circular Economy In Action


The InAction project, funded by Erasmus+ (KA210-YOU), has successfully concluded after two impactful years promoting youth engagement in zero-waste living and the circular economy across Poland, Cyprus, and Greece.


Led by Ekopotencjał Foundation (Poland), in partnership with STANDO LTD (Cyprus) and Innovation Footprint (Greece), InAction empowered young people to adopt sustainable habits and become active citizens through workshops, trainings, and hands-on learning.

### Key Achievements:

-  Surveyed 120+ youth on zero-waste habits
-  Created the InAction Youth Guide to Zero-Waste Lifestyle
-  Trained youth workers and tested resources in pilot workshops
-  Hosted public events reaching 60+ participants
-  Fostered cross-border collaboration for sustainability
